



How to Sign Up and Log on to SOC

Student Opportunity Center (SOC) is like “TripAdvisor” for Experiential Learning. Using this website you can explore and apply to thousands of:

As a student, this service is FREE for you to use (the college/university pays for it). Every user has a personalized experience based on their interests, major and location. Here’s a quick guide on how to get started:

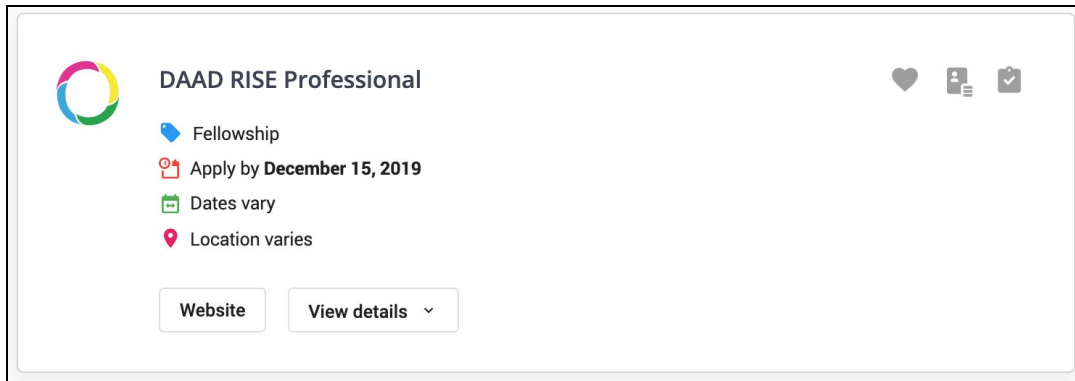
1. Log on to www.studentopportunitycenter.com and click on the **Log In** button on the top right corner.
2. Click on the **Sign Up** button and fill out the form. Please note that you will only be able to sign up using your @.edu email address.
3. Check your email for an activation email. The email subject should be “**Student Opportunity Center Account Confirmation**” and it should come from account@studentopportunitycenter.com. It may take a few minutes, and sometimes they end up in spam folder so be sure to wait and check.
4. Click on the **Verify** button to confirm your email address and activate your account.
5. After logging in, you can start searching for opportunities immediately - try entering your discipline or major or geographic location to get started.

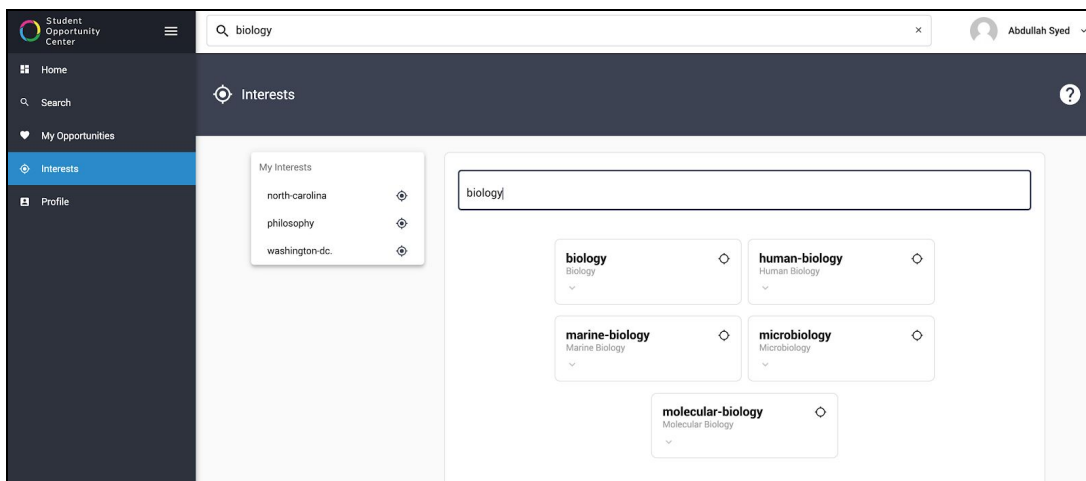
Here you will find the most relevant Conferences, Journals, Experiential Learning, and Funding opportunities for students. Our entire Database is tailored and sorted by relevance to you.
