



Memorandum of Understanding

Students who satisfactorily complete Honors courses at Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College with a B or better may receive up to 12 hours of Honors credit in The Honors College at Appalachian State University; additional Honors hours may be awarded with the permission of The Honors College Director.

Honors students from Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College may apply for regular admission to Appalachian State University and to The Honors College. Accepted students will schedule a meeting with The Honors College Director to review their Honors credits from Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College. Based on that review, the Honors College Director will determine how those courses will count towards the ASU Honors College curriculum.
