



Memorandum of Understanding

Students who satisfactorily complete Honors courses at South Piedmont Community College with a B or better may receive credit for up to 12 hours of Honors credit in The Honors College at Appalachian State University; additional Honors hours may be awarded with the permission of The Honors College Director.

Honors students from South Piedmont Community College may apply for regular admission to Appalachian State University and to The Honors College. Accepted students should schedule a meeting with The Honors College Director to review their Honors credits from South Piedmont Community College. Based on that review, the Honors College Director will determine how those courses will count towards the ASU Honors College curriculum.
